In 2006, The Fire Safety Order came into force, and replaced the Fire Precautions Act 1971 and the Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations. Since its introduction, many employers across the country still do not fully understand their responsibilities and we will fully explain these, plus discuss our enforcement procedures, appeals and any penalties and/or fines that the Courts have the power to impose.

- their responsibilities and duties under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order,
- Fire Risk Assessments, and
