Firefree RCT

Every time South Wales Fire and Rescue Service is called out to a grass or mountain fire, not only does it cost the taxpayer thousands of pounds, but it also means that Firefighters could be diverted from attending a real emergency - someone trapped in a house fire or a crashed car.

During the summer, a special Fire Crime Unit from South Wales Fire and Rescue Service will be working in Rhondda Cynon Taff (RCT) with the aim of achieving a 'Firefree RCT'. They'll be patrolling known hotspots on the look out for any suspicious behaviour, arranging competitions and sports tournaments for local youngsters and other engagement and diversionary activities.
