The main duties of the post will include:

- Acting as press officer for media or campaign filming opportunities, as part of the agreed department processes, to ensure consistency and that the Service is being represented in an appropriate manner throughout.
- To write and issue press releases and features, to inform the media and public about the role, safety messages and activities of South Wales Fire and Rescue Service (SWFRS).
- To attend and participate in major and minor incidents, as well as attending exercises as required and co-ordinate media activity
- Handling daily press office / media enquiries relating to incidents attended by SWFRS. Creating proactive media relation opportunities with local and sector specific outlets.
