<p><b>Under the freedom of information act, Glyncoch Tenants &amp; Residents Association would like to establish the number of fire equipment disposed of and where to, such as fire hoses, breathing apparatus, safety clothing, defibrillators, fire engines, ladders etc.:</b></p> <p>Fire hoses - Metal ends are re-used, hose is scrapped</p> <p>Breathing Apparatus - Cylinders are re-used, other working parts are re-used. Any part which cannot be used is returned to supplier.</p> <p>Safety clothing - If unworn then we will re-use. Used kit is donated to Fire Fighters Charity</p> <p>Defibrillators - We have never had call to dispose of our defibrillators</p> <p>Fire Engines - These are either sent to auction or donated to Fire Aid. In 2017/2018 one rescue tender was auctioned and 3 Water Tenders were donated to Fire Aid.</p> <p>Ladders - If ladders are in working use then they are donated through Fire Aid. Anything which is unusable is scrapped for income.</p>
