<p>Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Please tell me:</p> <p>Please can you tell me how many times each year for the past three years officer from you fire and rescue service have been called to rescue officers on duty for other blue light emergency services such as the police and ambulance services.</p> <p>Please can you state the nature of each call out, as in how the emergency services officer needed to be rescued, the area it happened and the outcome of the call out.</p> <p>South Wales Fire and Rescue Service have no record of being called to rescue officers from other blue light emergency services in the past three years.</p> <p>There are two incidents where police offices attended hospital suffering from smoke inhalation but were not rescued on either occasion.</p>
