



# FIRE SAFETY CONCERNS IN CARE HOMES

#### 63% THINK THEIR PLACE OF WORK IS AT RISK OF FIRE




## 56 HAVE REPORTED A CONCERN ABOUT FIRE SAFETY.


With over half of those who reported a concern believing that unsatisfactory corrective action had been taken following their complaint.
