

FOI_IG0000552: NUMBER OF FIRES, FATALITIES AND INJURIES Response Date: 19/10/2020

FOI Request:

The following request for FOI Request has been received by SWFRS:

- I'd like to know the number of fires, fatalities and injuries in wales this year and the same figures for the three years prior, as well as the causes for all of them. Years: 2020, 2019, 2018, 2017
- I'd like to know the amount of fires outside of homes since lockdown started with comparable figure of the previous three years, and the causes behind them. Years: 2020, 2019, 2018, 2017
- A map of the areas in which the most fires have happened would also be good, if there is no map just the figures will be fine. Years: 2020, 2019, 2018, 2017.

Scope: Incidents attended by SWFRS from 01/01/2017 to 30/09/2020 recorded on the Incident Recording System (IRS). Please note that the request specified incidents relating to the 'Lockdown', for reference data has been taken from the 23rd of March 2020 (The date the UK Government announced a 'country-wide' lockdown) and runs until Wednesday 30th September 2020 as the most up to date complete monthly data set. SWFRS only holds data for its Service Area so only incidents from South Wales have been included.

Data: Incident report based on data extracted from SWFRS IRS on 19/10/2020 – data may be subject to change pending validation of IRS incident records.

Report criteria: Incident date 01/01/2017-30/09/2020,

Incident Type = Fire, excludes Over Border attendances, Fires including Injuries & Fatalities

IRS incidents where

Incident Category = Fire
Including = Where Injuries are Fire Related
Excluding = Over the Border Incidents
Including = Fires where injuries were present

Data may be subject to change, pending completion/validation of IRS records.
