MAIN PURPOSE OF THE POST

To manage the day-to-day activities of the Home Safety team and to contribute to the planning and implementation of service-wide Home Safety activities.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To maintain and contribute to the Department's wider community fire safety communications that is provided to all range of groups at risk from fire.
- To actively contribute to the service's risk reduction, community safety and home safety strategies.
- To work with internal and external stakeholders as determined by high-risk profiles within the communities.
- To assist in the development and monitoring of risk reduction presentations, initiatives, schemes, and programs to a wide range of community groups as aligned with NFCC Home safety strategies.
- To monitor and report on local performance indicators.
- To monitor and provide feedback from risk reduction projects with internal and external stakeholders.
- To assist in delivery and monitoring of data sharing protocols with partner organisations.
- To advise station personnel and other functions within the organisation of Home Safety issues.
- To represent the Department on internal and external committees (National Fire Chiefs Council) and the working parties of partner organisations as determined by Head of Home Safety & Fire Crime Manager.
- To assist in the collation, analysis, and presentation of management information.
- To maintain records and carry out stock checks of Home Safety equipment.
- Maintain and facilitate budgets for Home Safety to include exploring funding proposals for existing initiatives and opportunities.
- Working with procurement for future Home Safety risk reduction equipment.
- To manage the Home Safety Team, their workload and welfare needs.
- To maintain personal core competencies and help to develop those of others where appropriate.
- Any other duties commensurate with the post and grade.

• To observe and promote practices and activities which are within the Health and Safety, Diversity and Equal Opportunities policies of South Wales Fire & Rescue Service.
